- (7) The Commission may withdraw this Landing Permit and invoke sanctions if it is used contrary to the conditions of the permit without prior written approval of the Commission, or if false information on the actual usage of the Landing Permit is provided to the Commission.
- (8) You will be required to submit relevant data on telecommunications operators you are providing services to, upon request by the Commission.
- (9) You will also be required to provide information to the Commission on issues regarding your services as the need arises.
